





You can upload your own model of Learning Agreement, if necessary, but **IT IS COMPULSORY TO GENERATE CORRECTLY THE DRAFT OF THE URJC MODEL.**

The subjects\* (**TABLE A**) and the information in both models **MUST BE THE SAME.**
